

Reno County Fair Livestock Sale Scholarship Application

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be either:
 - A **high school senior**, or
 - A **college freshman**.
- Must be a **current 4-H or FFA member** and remain active through their final year of 4-H/FFA eligibility.
- Must have participated in the **market livestock program and Reno County Fair Livestock Sale for a minimum of four years**.
- Applicants may **receive this scholarship only once**.
- Completed applications must be submitted to the **Reno County Extension Office** by the deadline listed on the Extension website.

Please submit the following:

1. **Completed Application Form**
2. **Experience Reflection**
 - Respond to **each question separately in short-answer/paragraph form**.
 - There is **no required word count**; however, responses should be thoughtful, specific, and provide enough detail for the selection committee to understand your experiences and personal growth.
 - Please answer each of the following:
 - How have your livestock projects and participation in the county fair helped you grow as a person?
 - What skills, values, or lessons have you gained that you expect to carry into college, your career, or adult life?
 - Describe a challenge, accomplishment, relationship, or moment from your experience that had a meaningful impact on you.
 - What has the support of Premium Sale buyers and the local community meant to you beyond the financial contribution?
 - Looking back on your four years of participation, how has this experience helped prepare you for what comes next?
 - Describe the **most meaningful community service experience** you participated in during your high school years as a 4-H/FFA member. What was your role, who benefited from the experience, and why was it significant to you?
 - Describe your **leadership and involvement outside of 4-H and FFA** during grades 9–12. Include school, church, community, athletics, employment, or other organizations and activities. For each, briefly identify your involvement and any leadership roles, responsibilities, or contributions.
3. **Letter of Recommendation**
 - Include **one letter of recommendation** from a current or former **4-H Community Leader or FFA Advisor**.
4. **Senior Photo**
 - Clear, high-quality digital copy of senior photo emailed to dp96929@ksu.edu.

Formatting

- Complete all portions of the application using an **easy-to-read, 12-point font**.
- Clearly label each short-answer response with the corresponding question.
