

Reno County 4-H Premium Auction Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to sell a market animal at the Reno County Fair Premium Auction, members must complete the outlined requirements during the 4H program proceeding the start of the fair (August 1st through June 30th). This does NOT prevent the participant from entering items in the fair, however, it does dictate whether they are allowed to sell an animal at the conclusion of the fair. It is the member and their family's responsibility to complete the items and clearly mark them with an "X", providing the date of the event which will be verified by the Reno County Extension Office prior to the start of the fair. You should work with your club secretary, community leaders, Extension staff, and Fairboard/Sale Committee members to make sure the requirements have been met throughout the program year.

Timeframe to complete required activities: August 1– June 30 of the current year

Due: July 1st , along with fair entries.

Eligible activities include helping with set-up, tear-down, planning, or conducting an event. Attending as a participant does not count. Serving on the Fairboard, a committee, or as a superintendent counts as 2 activities.
