Therefore, junior contestants will NOT utilize the entire time for the contest and ALL contestants may leave when completed with all three areas of the competition – interview, identification and written test.

Senior – Identification, written test & interview
Intermediate – Identification, written test & interview
Junior – Identification, written test & interview

We will plan to announce the results during the awards luncheon on Monday, July 24th beginning at 11 am in the Meadowlark Building.

Age Divisions (as of January 1, 2023):
Junior – 7-11 years old
Intermediate – 12-15 years old
Senior – 16-19 years old
